





BLUE HIKE AND SEEK

- Step 1: Starting at the Blue Trailhead, head West.
- Step 2: Follow the curve until you are facing <u>South</u>. Notice the <u>Creek</u> up ahead.
- Step 3: Continue walking the trail. Pause when you have a small <u>building</u> directly to the <u>East</u> of the trail.
- Step 4: Continue walking the trail until you come out of the trees. Face West and see the Creek again.
- Step 5: Continue till the bend in the trail. Notice the <u>Creek</u> to the <u>South-West</u>. A little further on notice the <u>Creek</u> right next to the trail.
- Step 6: Continue until the <u>Pond</u> it directly <u>North</u> of you. Do you see any <u>Birds</u> in or near the <u>Pond</u>?



Write down what Birds you see here:

Step 7: Continue down the trail until there is an odd <u>circle patch of weeds</u> to the <u>East</u> and <u>Pine Trees</u> to your <u>West</u>. What do you think caused this circle of weeds to grow like that?

Pro Tip: a pine tree can have needles like this

and this

- Step 8: Round the corner of the <u>Pine Tree</u> patch and you will see the <u>Clubhouse</u> to your <u>North</u>.
- > Step 9: Continue on the trail back to the <u>Clubhouse</u>.

How to navigate with a compass:

- 1. Hold the compass flat/level.
- 2. Turn the dial so that the N lines up with the arrow and the S lines up with the string.
- 3. Turn yourself and the compass till the red side of the needle is pointing at the N.
- 4. You are now facing North.
- 5. As you turn, the red side of the needle will continue to point in the North direction.
- 6. Whenever you need to re-orient yourself, start with step 1.
